



Significant changes are coming to VA health care and benefits expansion as a result of the PACT Act, bringing about the following changes:

- Expanding and extending eligibility for VA health care for Veterans with toxic exposures and Veterans of the Vietnam, Gulf War, and post-9/11 eras**
- Adds more than 20 new presumptive conditions for burn pits and other toxic exposures**
- Adds more presumptive-exposure locations for Agent Orange and radiation**
- Requires VA to provide a toxic exposure screening to every Veteran enrolled in VA health care**
- Helps the VA improve research, staff education, and treatment related to toxic exposures**
